Footnotes

SO BUSTED threw his head at the start, altered course to the inside avoiding DA GRIZZ soon after the break, made steady progress racing into the second bend to gain contention, shifted out on the turn to split foes three deep in upper stretch, wrested command nearing the furlong marker and turned back a challenge from FAST PROMISES under firm left handed pressure to prevail. The latter broke a step slowly, settled near the inside in the opening half, gathered momentum saving ground on the second bend, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes four deep, bid outside the winner leaving the furlong marker but was outkicked. SIR REDFORD tracked off the second flight along the inside under some reserve, briefly awaited an opening racing through the far turn, shifted out of some traffic in upper stretch to race between foes and continued well enough to gain a share. COUNT DE BARAN tracked the leaders unhurried from well out of striking distance off the inside, split foes three deep racing through the far turn, angled six wide entering upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. APACHE STORM sped to the fore along the inside, disputed the pace inside a rival into the far turn and gave way leaving midstretch. JUNGLE HEART tracked just off the first flight between foes into the backstretch, made a brief bid three wide on the far turn but flattened out near midstretch. DA GRIZZ, bumped, then clipped by BIG SIX in the opening stages, was forced to check off that rival, settled outside foes for a half, angled out five wide on the far turn while making some progress but lacked the needed final response. COOL CLUE was urged to gain a contending position while angling inwards entering the first turn, pressed the pace outside a rival racing into the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. JAYBIRD'S MIRACLE tracked

off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch and came up empty on the far turn. JOY FROM PHOENIX, caught four wide while being urged to a forward placing racing into the first turn, continued four deep into the second bend and steadily faded from contention. BIG SIX was briskly urged to contend while shifting inwards just after the start, clipped DA GRIZZ, continued three deep into the backstretch racing just off the leaders, was spent after a half and quickly retreated. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT JUST AFTER THE START BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
