Footnotes

CRAZY BEAR, forwardly placed between foes in the opening stages, shook clear entering the turn, then held sway on a clear margin to the end while being kept to steady pressure. SHOPPING CART broke slowly, worked her way to the inside tracking off the second flight between foes, angled to the rail in upper stretch and continued with interest to secure the place inside foes. TOP PAIR shifted off the inside early gaining position between foes in the second flight, shifted out three wide on the turn commencing her advance, raced four deep into upper stretch to challenge but finished evenly in the last furlong. DAMA DAMA was urged to dispute the pace along the rail racing into the bend, couldn't match the winner while shifting outside that foe in upper stretch and gave way. STIVERS SUPRISE settled outside foes in the opening stages, made some progress four deep on the bend, angled out five wide racing through the stretch and made some mild progress. SCARLET TEE tracked off the second flight near the inside, angled out entering upper stretch and continued evenly between rivals. WILMINGTON settled near the inside early, saved ground to upper stretch, made some progress to improve position but made no real impact. AFFECTION settled between foes in early stages and never gained contention. ITALIAN REVOLUTION tracked between foes off the second flight in the opening quarter but came up empty on the turn. LE BEE angled inwards while briefly contesting the pace four wide in the opening quarter but dropped out early. COZEY DEEDS raced five wide to the turn and steadily faded from contention. SEE YOU THEN CART angled sharply to the inside early but trailed throughout.
