PRETTY CHAMP was urged to dispute the lead inside a rival from the break, moved clear after the opening furlong, set the pace along the inside to upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to hold safe TURTLE PIE under encouragement despite the loss of her rider's whip in upper stretch. The latter broke readily to gain even terms with the eventual winner in the opening stages, relinquished the lead to stalk that foe under light rating racing to the bend, was urged to challenge nearing upper stretch and closed the gap late while always second best. SCREEN SIREN tracked the leaders near the inside in second flight, shifted out racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress to gain a share. DOROTHY Y tracked off the second flight while angling to the inside nearing the turn and made some mild progress to late stages. ANEWPAIROFSHOES broke outwards momentarily impeding MIDWINTER, was settled into stride in last racing to the turn and never gained contention. MIDWINTER, forced outwards at the start, recovered to gain a position three deep racing just off the pacesetter into the turn, but came up empty entering upper stretch and was vanned off the course after the race.
