### Footnotes

WISTFUL SMILE broke sharply to secure the lead along the inside, dictated the pace in hand just off the inside racing to the far turn, was urged to maintain his advantage while drifting out a bit in late stages but just lasted under firm handling. LITTLE FEAT tracked the pacesetter outside a rival racing to the backstretch, was urged to advance on the leader racing through the far turn, shifted out avoiding that foe in late stages but couldn't gain even terms while narrowly prevailing for place honors. UNBRIDLED VICAR, reserved saving ground in the opening half, steadily drew into contention while shifting out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly to the end to edge a rival for a share. SICOMORO tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight, advanced to striking position along the rail racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to the end while being just outfinished for a share. BISHOP CASEY tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, shifted four wide racing into upper stretch while being urged to advance, continued in close quarters past midstretch and was just outkicked. COURTLY tracked off the second flight racing to the backstretch and continued evenly along the inside to late stages. YAROSLAV, reserved outside a rival in the last flight early, never gained contention. BIG POPPA D was settled along the inside early and never seriously menaced. CHARBOURG tracked just off the pacesetter under rating racing to the backstretch but quickly emptied out racing through the far turn.
