HEAVEN'S FLAME stalked the pace while four wide and lacked the needed kick. GENTLE LANA outrun early, entered the stretch four wide and lodged a mild bid. JETTIN TWISTER set a contested pace, was headed on the turn and gave way. PADDY WAK WAKIE never menaced. MARKET AT MIDDAY retreated.
