**Footnotes**

HANGER THIRTYEIGHT was hustled from between foes to the fore, angled to the rail disputing the issue inside foes, edged forward to a clear advantage in upper stretch and gamely held the challenge of HELLO SAILOR in a prolonged drive. The latter, urged to the fore outside foes, pressed the issue three deep into upper stretch, closed the gap on the winner late and was narrowly outfinished. DAAREB tracked off the second flight between foes, shifted out four wide racing into the turn, then continued in that path into upper stretch while finishing willingly for a share. THIEF tracked the leaders in second flight four deep between foes early, angled inwards entering the bend, then shifted inside the leaders near midstretch while being outfinished for a share. HOLY THURSDAY tracked off the second flight six wide in the opening quarter, continued between foes four deep on the bend and improved position five wide racing into the stretch. LISSA'S STAR was urged to a forward placing inside foes, tracked the leaders in second flight along the rail racing into the turn, saved ground to upper stretch and weakened in late stages. TRUST NOBODY tracked off the second flight between foes and continued evenly three deep

into the stretch. GUT KING tracked the pace five wide racing off the second flight early and never gained contention. PERIMETER DEFENSE broke awkwardly, raced wide throughout and proved no factor. ABOUNDING APTITUDE tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside and never mounted a serious challenge. CODIGO POSTAL never seriously menaced. STRONG STAG angled inwards while being urged to secure terms with the pacesetter between foes, disputed the issue racing into the bend and gave way abruptly entering upper stretch.
