MY MY MY MARIA, held up off the leaders near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out to bid between foes entering the far turn, moved to wrest command midway through the second bend, then turned back a challenge from BERRY KNOLL to prevail. The latter was reserved off the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out entering the far turn advancing on the leaders four deep, moved to challenge for command in that path midstretch and was just outfinished. DARLAND settled saving ground early, shifted out leaving the far turn, angled five wide racing through the stretch and made an effort to improve position. ABUELA EMMA, caught four wide racing into the first turn, moved to lodge a brief bid three deep between foes on the far turn but came up empty in upper stretch. IONES FOLLY angled inwards tracking off the second flight racing to the backstretch, was steadied out of close quarters along the rail approaching the far turn and quickly came up empty. LOCK N LOLA, urged to set the pace along the inside, dueled for command into the far turn and gave way after six furlongs. UNREGULATED, urged to secure a forward placing tracking the pacesetter, was spent after a half, was outdistanced in upper stretch and reportedly bled.
