ARCTIC POINT was hustled to the lead along the inside from the break, dictated the pace along the rail into the bend, shook clear when challenged midway through the bend and held sway to the end under firm handling. PRETEND AND EXTEND tracked the leaders five deep in second flight early, was urged to challenge the leader while shifting inwards entering the turn but couldn't gain even terms with that foe while proving best of the others. ADDAWAY RAJ, allowed to settle near the inside racing to the bend, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and found his best stride late to prevail for a share. SIR SHAUN tracked the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight under light rating early, came through inside foes to advance when presented an opening leaving the turn and continued evenly into the stretch while missing for a share. VARACRUZ raced four wide between foes under rating in the second flight in the opening stages, was urged to advance three deep racing through the turn but lacked the needed closing response. OF COURSE CARTER was settled outside foes off the second flight early, came under pressure racing through the turn but lacked response. BOTTOM LES PIT, urged to secure a forward placing tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the bend, came up empty after a half. BRONCHITO trailed throughout.
