HELICOPTER leaned out at the start, reserved along the inside, angled three wide at the three-sixteenths marker and rallied under pressure. GO TO THE SUN settled well, advanced on the far turn, moved four wide into the stretch and kept on. KNOB CREEK outpaced while three wide, gained the lead into the stretch and stayed on. FACE THE FIRE stalked the pace and weakened. BIG BOLD PLACE grabbed the lead, was headed on the far turn and yielded. WAYOFF was always outrun. PRIME REALESTATE settled well and faded.
