HOLY STARLITE was never a factor. DIXIE DREAMER made a mild bid in the stretch and faltered. BOOK THE BULLET raced off the rail and gave way. COFFEE SHOP lacked speed while outrun. BIRDIE ONTHE GREEN raced off the rail and gave way. WILD HOUSE raced close up off the rail and tired.
