Footnotes

GALLANT PLEASURE, reserved off the second flight while being guided to the rail in the opening stages, saved ground tracking the leaders unhurried on the bend, shifted out nearing midstretch while being roused to advance, then wrested command in late stages, prevailing under firm encouragement. EIGHTEEN WHEELS angled to the inside in the opening stages taking up a position just off the first flight, came through when presented an opening racing into upper stretch to gain a clear advantage but couldn't quite fend off the winner. ABACO STORM settled four wide wide between foes off the second flight in the opening stages, altered course abruptly nearing the turn to race along the rail, saved ground to upper stretch and continued well enough to earn a share. PETER LOUIS angled inwards a bit while moving to the fore, dictated the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the inside into the turn, dueled for command between foes into the lane and gave way midstretch. BUTTERCUPS BABY settled into stride shifting off the inside and gained some position between foes late while never making a real impression. PROUD JACKSON tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the turn but

offered no closing bid. HESTON attended the pace between foes racing in the three path early, pressed the issue on the turn and emptied out racing into upper stretch. STATE PARK tracked off the second flight three wide between foes in the opening stages but lacked a rally. REBUTTABLE, held up along the rail in the opening stages, shifted out five wide racing into the turn but never seriously menaced. PURPLEGREENANDGOLD, caught five wide tracking the leaders in second flight racing into the bend, steadily faded after a half. CURZON STREET, bumped at the start, settled in the last flight and never seriously menaced. ON THE RUN, caught four wide in the opening quarter chasing the leaders, steadily retreated after a half.
