Footnotes

SON OF TIGER, reserved saving ground in last racing to the backstretch, shifted out while steadily moving to striking position between foes racing into the far turn while remaining under rating, split foes three deep leaving the quarter mile marker to challenge for command, gained a narrow advantage midstretch and just held CARTOUCHE under steady handling. The latter tracked just off the leaders along the rail racing to the far turn, came through when presented an opening to challenge inside foes leaving the quarter mile marker, pressed the issue to late stages and was just outkicked. WHERE'S WINSTON moved to terms with a rival on the pace in the opening stages attending the pace, moved to press that foe on the far turn to upper stretch while shifting out a bit and gave way leaving the furlong marker while continuing well enough to earn a share. SWEETEST RHYTHM tracked off the first flight outside a rival in the opening half, moved to challenge three deep racing through the far turn but flattened out in upper stretch. RULEROUS was roused to the fore along the inside racing to the backstretch, set the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn and emptied out entering upper stretch.
