Footnotes

KANIJA, prompted to secure a contending position along the inside in the opening stages, was taken in hand after the opening furlong to track just off the pacesetter under reserve saving ground into the turn, shifted off the inside in upper stretch, then came through close quarters nearing the furlong marker to challenge, and prevailed in time under firm right encouragement. SEA WHY was roused to the lead while angling to the inside early, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing through the turn, edged forward in upper stretch, held sway past the furlong marker and resisted the winner to the end. PASSPOST TO PARIS pulled her way to terms with the first flight to join the pace between foes after the opening quarter, pressed the issue to upper stretch and weakened late. POCANELLA settled in last along the rail racing to the bend, shifted out in upper stretch, then steadily improved position while angling out five deep in late stages. CLEVER OUTLET made a steady advance to contention three deep between foes in the opening stages, chased the leaders in that path to upper stretch but weakened late. J'S HONOR, held up out of tight quarters while between foes in the opening quarter, shifted out racing into upper stretch but had no closing bid. ROYAL RENAISSANCE broke outwards bumping BALLYGAWLEY, was righted to track outside foes in the second flight racing to the bend, made a brief bid four wide between foes on the turn but quickly faded in upper stretch. BALLYGAWLEY, bumped at the start, was caught five wide racing into the turn and lacked a closing response.
