PERFECT STRANGER went up to join the pace between foes racing into the first turn, moved clear entering the backstretch, steadily widened her advantage racing into upper stretch and was kept to the task. DUBIOUS broke inwards making some contact with BONNIE at the start, was settled in last racing off the inside to the backstretch, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch and made solid progress late to gain place honors. LITTLE FRANCES, forwardly placed along the inside while on terms with several rivals on the pace racing to the backstretch, tracked the pacesetter inside a rival to the second bend and steadily weakened when failing to regain terms with that foe. CYBERPHOBE, in close attendance to the pace three deep early, tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in second flight to the far turn and steadily faded racing into the stretch. POINT YOUR FINGER was settled outside a rival from out of striking distance in the opening half, angled four wide racing into upper stretch but offered no closing bid. BONNIE, bumped at the start, was held up along the inside racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. MYA FACCIA BELLA tracked just off the leaders near the inside in the opening half and steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
