Footnotes

COWGIRL KNOCKOUT gained terms with a rival soon after the start attending that foe's pace in hand in the opening stages, forced the issue on the turn, moved clear nearing upper stretch and made the balance of the pace under firm right handed encouragement. DREYMORE tracked the pace inside foes in second flight, shifted out to split rivals nearing the quarter mile marker, switched outside the pacesetter to challenge in the four path in upper stretch but was always only second best. SHARE THE JOY, urged to dispute the pace inside a rival from the outset, dueled for command racing into the turn and gave way in upper stretch. LICA'S BLUFF was settled in last along the inside racing to the turn, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch but made no impression. OCEAN SURGE tracked the leaders three deep as part of the second flight racing into the turn and steadily faded after a half. SPANISH ROYALTY settled into stride off and outside the second flight, was caught four, then three deep racing through the but never seriously menaced.
