DUBIOUS, reserved in last near the inside racing into the backstretch, swung out nearing the far turn commencing a steady four wide advance, circled foes racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to just edge GLORIOUS DESTINY in the final strides under brisk right handed encouragement. The latter moved readily to the fore while shifting to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the far turn, shook clear racing into upper stretch, held sway past the furlong marker and just missed. SPACE OF TIME moved to gain a position outside a rival tracking the pacesetter in second flight in the opening half, was urged to lodge a brief bid racing through the far turn but flattened out in upper stretch. ARRESTED BY DUFFY, reserved in hand while being guided to the inside early, came around a tiring foe racing into the far turn, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. TSUNAMI SALLI hopped at the start, was settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, was caught five wide racing through the far turn to upper stretch and continued evenly while gaining some position. HURRICANE KATIE, urged to secure a forward placing tracking just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, was urged to maintain that position racing through the far turn but came up empty nearing upper stretch. UNDER THE RIM, held up between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch, couldn't produce the needed closing response. A. J.'S LOVE tracked the leaders along the inside behind the second flight in the opening stages, shifted out while being urged to make a brief bid racing into the far turn but quickly flattened out. ANCIENT EYES tracked off the second flight between foes racing into the backstretch, was shuffled a bit avoiding tight quarters near the eleven sixteenths marker and shifted to the inside while quickly dropping out. GOSTOSA, urged to contend four wide racing into the first turn racing off the second flight, continued in that path to the second bend and emptied out nearing upper stretch.
