Racing:

JIMMY GOT EVEN was settled in last racing well off the inside in the opening quarter, steadily gathered momentum on the turn splitting foes nearing upper stretch, angled out six wide entering the lane and produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under steady pressure. CITY NUMBER tracked the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, made steady progress while shifting outside the leader entering upper stretch, gained the advantage between calls in late stages but proved no match when confronted by the winner late, then was vanned off the course following the race. LEE CHAPEL broke sharply despite being brushed at the start, sprinted clear of his foes along the inside racing into the turn, maintained the advantage to midstretch but yielded to the top pair late. CALL TO GLORY tracked off the second flight five wide in the opening stages, continued with a steady advance racing four wide on the turn, shifted five wide in upper stretch and finished evenly in the closing stages while gaining some position. ROAR OF THUNDER broke inwards brushing LEE CHAPEL, threw his head while being collected off that foe, tracked off the second flight while shifting to the inside on the turn, made some brief progress inside foes racing into the lane but lacked the needed final kick. ONE FOR BISCUIT settled into stride off the inside racing to the turn and never seriously menaced while gaining some position eight deep in the last furlong. QUALITY DIPLOMAT was urged to gain a position three deep in the second flight racing into the turn and gave way after a half. BIG BAD MIKE tracked the pace three wide between foes in the last flight early and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. INDIAN SUOVENIR was a brief factor along the inside but retreated from contention early. TETON MOTEL was urged to gain a position leading the second flight between foes racing into the turn, couldn't gain terms with the pacesetter and gave way racing into upper stretch.
