Footnotes

ENEMY FIRE took up a position tracking just off the pacesetter outside a rival under light rating in the opening stages, commenced a steady advance entering the turn to gain terms with the leader after a half, was roused to take charge entering upper stretch and extended the margin to the end under firm encouragement. HURTA tracked the pacesetter inside a rival in the second flight, continued under patient handling inside foes racing into the bend, shifted outside a tiring foe racing into upper stretch while continuing with a steady effort and prevailed for the place honors late while failing to menace the winner. KELA'S ASSAULT tracked off the second flight while angling inside early, was urged to advance between foes racing into the turn and continued evenly in late stages while being just outkicked for second. WILDWOOD PERFECT ducked out at the start, settled into stride six wide early, then came around foes racing into the stretch to improve position five wide in late stages. LATE DEVELOPER tracked the pacesetter three deep in the second flight racing into the bend and steadily faded after a half. CHAPTER TWELVE, a bit slow into stride, never gained contention. PROUD JACKSON was urged to secure the lead from the break while angling to the inside, dictated the pace for a half and gave way abruptly racing into upper stretch. ELROYSTHEBOY retreated from contention between foes early.
