Footnotes

HE'S GOT TO RUN, within striking distance three deep while under light rating racing to the backstretch, moved to press the issue in that path after a half, gained a clear advantage racing into upper stretch and steadily widened his margin under firm encouragement. SWEET CRUDE tracked off the first flight from just out of striking distance outside a rival racing to the backstretch, moved to challenge the leaders three deep racing through the far turn, couldn't gain terms with the winner but edged a rival on the wire for place honors. MOST DISTINCT broke sharply to gain a narrow advantage along the rail racing into the first turn, disputed the pace along the rail into the second bend and gave way midstretch when proving no match. HEART DOCTOR, urged to terms with a rival on the pace racing into the first turn, continued between foes in the first flight racing through the backstretch, lost some position to the leaders on the far turn and steadily faded entering upper stretch. KELPIE tracked off the first flight along the inside racing to the far turn but offered no closing bid. KEY TO WINNING trailed throughout.
