Footnotes

TOUGH JODI within striking distance from the outset four deep under light rating in the opening stages, steadily moved to terms with the pacesetter on the turn, gained a clear advantage racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end in a ridden out effort. LUSK, bumped at the start, was righted to track off the second flight racing to the turn, shifted out three wide nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance and proved best of the others. TIDY UP bobbled at the start bumping GREATTOBEABEAVAR, was settled along the inside, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. GREATTOBEABEAVAR, bumped at the start, was held up just off the leaders along the inside racing into the turn, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. POWER CHIPPED was settled outside foes in early stages and never seriously menaced. HERE COMES HENRY broke out bumping LUSK, was righted to flash brief pace along the inside but was spent after three furlongs. THISCATCANS CAT, urged between foes to gain a narrow advantage in the opening quarter, dueled for command off the inside racing through the turn, gave way nearing upper stretch, then was vanned off the course after the race having reportedly bled.
