Footnotes

MICHALINA, prominent five deep in the opening stages, made steady progress four wide on the turn to gain terms with the pacesetter racing into upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under firm handling. BEA'S HARD SIX broke outwards brushing SECRET GLITTER, was righted quickly to set the pace along the inside racing into the turn, held sway on a narrow margin past the furlong marker but couldn't fend off the winner's final bid. SECRET GLITTER, brushed at the start, tracked in second flight between foes under some reserve racing into the bend, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress to gain a share. PECOSA was rated along the rail tracking just off the leaders racing into the bend, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked the needed closing response. NUT 'N BUTTER, forwardly placed between foes near the inside stalking just off the pacesetter racing into the turn, gave way after a half. PEACH BOTTOM settled six wide in the opening stages and never gained striking distance while passing some tiring foes late. QUEENLASEFA tracked the leader four deep in second flight racing into the turn but never seriously menaced. EVERYBODY LIES was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge. LOVE TRIAL, forwardly placed three deep between foes tracking the pacesetter, emptied out after a half.
