GLOBAL ALLIANCE, in touch with a rival on the pace from the outset, moved to press the issue racing into upper stretch, then edged clear in the final stages under firm handling. B TWO SPECIAL stalked just off the first flight three deep in the opening quarter, was urged to challenge in that path nearing upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner late but prevailed for second. EXPLOSIVE WAR broke sharply, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the inside racing to the turn, resisted the winner's challenge past midstretch but yielded late. NO MO MOE bobbled, then was bumped at the start, made steady progress nearing the turn to gain a position between foes in the second flight, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. AUGUST DAY tracked just off the first flight a bit off the inside racing into the turn but had no closing response. LAKOTA WOLF, a step slow into stride, tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance along the rail racing into the turn but offered no rally. SACRED RANGE settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. IOLANDA'S PERFECT broke inwards bumping NO MO MOE, was righted to make brief progress four wide in second flight racing into turn but gave way early.
