MISTER MARTI GRAS took up a position outside a rival racing off the second flight in the opening stages while under light rating, gathered momentum splitting foes nearing upper stretch, shifted four wide entering the lane and responded to firm left handed encouragement to wrest command in time. ALL STORMY, pulling a bit along the inside tracking just off the first flight racing into the backstretch, shifted out three deep midway through the far turn while moving to challenge for command, gained the advantage approaching midstretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner late. AFFORD tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch, was fanned four wide leaving the far turn and lacked the needed final response while continuing well enough to prevail for a share. FRANCOIS settled into stride outside foes racing in last to the backstretch, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch while gaining some position late but made no real impression. HOPE FOR TODAY gained terms with a rival on the pace prompting that foe racing into the backstretch, edged forward of that foe nearing upper stretch to set the pace along the inside into upper stretch but faltered nearing the furlong marker. BOWMANS CASTLE angled to the inside early tracking off the second flight racing to the far turn but lacked the needed late response. SHADOWBDANCING sped to the lead along the rail to dictate the pace on a narrow margin in the opening half, dueled for command racing into the far turn and gave way after six furlongs.
