SATURDAY DANCE, within striking distance between foes in the opening stages, was rated between foes in the second flight while dropping a bit off the leaders nearing the turn, continued with a steady bid gaining position between rivals to draw on terms with the pacesetter nearing upper stretch, shifted out three wide entering the lane and responded to firm left handed encouragement to wrest command in time. MOONBLAST broke sharply, disputed the pace three deep in the opening stages, gained a clear advantage racing into the turn while shifting nearer to the inside, held sway into upper stretch but couldn't fend off the winner's final bid. NEWS BULLETIN tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight in the opening stages, was shuffled out of close quarters leaving the half mile marker, shifted to the inside racing into the bend and continued with a steady effort to improve his position inside foes racing into the stretch. MOB BOSS broke a bit awkwardly, settled into stride while angling inside, saved ground to upper stretch and gained some position inside foes in late stages. LIGHTNING FIR tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out racing into upper stretch and steadily faded in late stages. PEACE NOW was urged to dispute the pace along the inside racing into the turn, couldn't match the leader after a half and emptied out nearing midstretch. CUARTO CUATES was urged to gain a position five wide in the second flight in the opening quarter, continued in that path into the turn and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. GAVILAN settled into stride along the inside early but never seriously menaced. COWBOY JONES broke outwards making some contact with ROYAL JAKE at the start, was urged to gain contention three wide between foes in the opening quarter but retreated from contention early. ROYAL JAKE hopped, then was bumped at the start, was urged to a contending position four wide between foes in the opening stages but was spent early.
