### Footnotes

SPREAD THE CHIPS was settled into stride along the rail in the opening stages while steadily moving to terms with the second flight, continued with a steady advance inside foes racing into upper stretch, came through to challenge when presented an opening nearing the sixteenth marker and narrowly prevailed in time under firm right handed encouragement. TEST MARKET tracked just off the pacesetter along the inside under light rating early, came through to challenge along the rail entering upper stretch while making some light contact with CITOYEN STYLE, then drifted out in the final sixteenth while just failing to contain the winner. CITOYEN STYLE was hustled clear from between foes soon after the start, set the pace a bit off the inside racing into the bend, held sway on a narrow margin racing into upper stretch, was brushed nearing the furlong marker, then drifted out markedly in late stages, crossing into the path of MILWAUKEE WOLF. MILWAUKEE WOLF, held up between foes in the opening stages, tracked the leaders three deep in second flight racing into the bend, steadily moved to striking distance while angling out four wide racing into upper stretch, bid between foes in that path but was outfinished while being carried out a bit late. U STEP ASIDE, urged to terms with the pacesetter in the opening sixteenth, was eased off the leader to track that foe three deep racing into the bend, moved to challenge in that path nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick while finishing in close quarters in the final sixteenth. NO LIP tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight, was eased back from that position entering the bend, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch while being urged to advance but lacked the needed final kick. CARL'S C NOTE settled well off the field while working his way to the inside racing to the turn, saved ground on the bend, then shifted out in upper stretch to make some mild progress between foes. CHEROKEE TALK was never a factor.
