Footnotes

COCKY BULL, reserved off the first flight from just out of striking distance while between foes in the opening stages, steadily gathered momentum leaving the turn while shifting out four wide nearing upper stretch, moved to wrest command from the leaders nearing the sixteenth marker and pulled clear late under firm handling. STORM CROSSED was urged to dispute the pace inside foes racing into the turn, continued in an extended skirmish while being bumped by GREAT BAM nearing midstretch, couldn't fend off the winner's bid but held a rival for place honors. GREAT BAM, urged to dispute the pace between foes soon after the break, dueled for command outside a rival into upper stretch, shifted inwards nearing the furlong marker bumping STORM CROSSED and was outfinished for second while failing to contain the winner. DONT TOUCH MY GOLD tracked off the second flight outside foes through the backstretch, made steady progress outside foes on the bend, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch then continued with an even effort in that path to late stages. BLUE DAY IN MAY, held up out of close quarters soon after the start, tracked off the second flight near the inside racing into the turn, shifted out four wide racing through the stretch and made an effort to improve position. CAST A COLD EYE tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing into the turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. HIP HOPPER was settled outside foes in early stages, angled six wide racing into upper stretch and passed some tiring rivals. CELTIC EXPRESS settled into stride near the inside on the backstretch and never seriously menaced. QUISP

was roused to the fore three deep in the opening stages, pressed the issue in that path into the bend and emptied out entering upper stretch. ON THE RUN tracked the leaders five wide on the backstretch and soon dropped out of contention.
