J S P PALS FOREVER broke readily to secure a forward placing, stalked just off the pacesetter under light rating to the turn, moved to force the issue racing into upper stretch and edged clear late under firm handling. AND HOW settled into stride while angling to the inside in the opening quarter, gathered momentum saving ground racing through the bend, shifted out four wide splitting rivals racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to prevail for place honors. SPEEDY WAR sprinted to the lead along the inside from the break, set the pace into the turn, briefly resisted the winner's challenge racing into upper stretch but weakened late. HARBORTON, urged to gain a position three deep in the second flight in the opening stages, continued in that position into upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. NAUGHTY AND NICE, in touch with the leaders between foes in the opening furlong, eased off the pace to track off the second flight racing through the turn and had no closing response. PARTY VISION reared at the start, was urged to gain a position just off the leaders along the inside racing as part of the second flight but steadily faded after a half. SILKY SAMI settled into stride off the inside early and never seriously menaced. EVERYBODY LIES tracked off the second flight outside foes early, raced five wide through the turn to upper stretch and proved empty in the drive.
