WEGGIE settled in early, made his move heading for home, got through inside in the lane and drew clear. THREE TICKETS broke sharply, stalked the pace, had a brief lead and held the place. NOLAN'S TERRITORY raced in the second flight early, made a bid four wide but was not good enough. PETERMAN was void of early speed then closed willingly five wide. CREOLE'S AFFAIR set a pressured pace and gave way in the stretch. MESMERITE raced slow early and passed tiring rivals. CHARTER CLASS stalked the pace, took the lead on the backstretch and faded. TIMELESS FACTS was through early and no factor. WHERE'S WINSTON flashed brief foot and raced widest in the stretch. STRONG STAG raced mid pack and lacked a late response.
