Footnotes

CHAMP DIMARE, never far back, drew on terms with the pacesetter after a half while under her own courage, then was roused clear racing through the stretch. DAKOTA SONG was urged to secure the lead a bit off the inside, angled inwards on the turn, set the pace into upper stretch, couldn't match the winner but proved best of the others. UTESA, between foes in second flight early, chased the leaders into upper stretch but made no impression on the top pair while continuing well enough to gain a share. HATS N' HEELS stumbled at the start, settled into stride near the inside, split foes near the inside entering upper stretch and improved her position to the end. STRONG N TRUE, forwardly placed just inside the leaders racing into the bend, steadily weakened nearing upper stretch. MY KENTUCKY BREEZE shied from a rival at the start, settled into stride, then improved her position along the inside racing into the stretch. VERY VERO tracked off the second flight early, shifted out to race three deep between foes on the turn and steadily faded in the drive. KAREN'S ANGEL tracked the leaders in second flight along the inside racing into the turn but lacked the needed late response. WINNER ALL RIGHT raced four wide into the turn as part of the second flight and gave way early. DON'TTELLMOMEITHER never seriously menaced.
