Footnotes

SILK OF SARI gained a tracking position in the second flight just off inside in the opening stages, shifted out on the turn to advance on the leaders three deep, split foes in that path nearing upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and drew away under steady encouragement. SHEESA GUSKA DEVIL shifted inwards at the start, was held up in the second flight while making her way to the rail, tracked just off the pacesetter to upper stretch, shifted out in late stages and prevailed for the place. GAMBLER FIVE settled near the inside early, saved ground on the bend steadily advancing to contention, swerved out of close quarters nearing the furlong marker impeding WILDCAT MISS but continued with interest to gain a share. PECOSA was hustled to dispute the pace inside a rival from the outset, gained a narrow advantage after a half but weakened once headed by the winner. PREMIUM CUT tracked the leaders unhurried near the inside, split foes gathering momentum after a half, angled four wide in upper stretch, steadied momentarily avoiding traffic near the furlong marker and had no final response. SCARLETT'S SEQUEL, bumped at the start, settled outside foes, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress. LUCK BE A LADYBUG broke outwards bumping SCARLETT'S SEQUEL, was righted to track outside foes in

the second flight racing to the turn but steadily faded after a half. KNOTTS tracked off the second flight five wide racing into the bend and never reached contention. WILDCAT MISS was urged to dispute the pace outside a rival racing into the turn, gave way in upper stretch,, then was clipped and forced to check off GAMBLER FIVE near the furlong marker losing all momentum. MODESTA settled outside foes in the opening stages and never seriously menaced. FASHION N' FUN joined the pace three wide soon after the break, pressed the issue racing into the turn, drifted out after a half and soon gave way. ON A JET PLANE, fractious in the gate, delayed the start, was held up out of tight quarters at the break and trailed throughout. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN AND DISQUALIFIED GAMBLER FIVE FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HIM NINTH.
