Footnotes

BETTER SAFE, within striking distance three deep racing just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, was carried out a bit by that foe nearing upper stretch but continued with a steady response to wrest command and forge clear late under firm encouragement. AND HOW broke outwards bumping SURFIN WAVE, was righted to track off the second flight in the opening stages, split foes nearing upper stretch to bid inside the winner but came up second best. TELMA tracked off the second flight outside rivals racing to the bend, then split foes three deep racing through the stretch in an effort to improve his position. WILD STORY shifted inwards while being urged to secure the lead just outside a rival in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin

into the bend, drifted out nearing upper stretch and soon gave way. JELLY BUTTER settled along the inside early, saved ground throughout and made an effort to improve her position inside foes. COURTESY CALL tracked off the second flight near the inside early, switched out four wide racing through the turn and continued evenly in that path between foes to the end. ANYONESHOME, held up outside foes in the second flight early, made steady progress four wide racing into the bend to gain contention after a half but lacked the needed final response. TAKE MANHATTAN, forwardly placed along the inside attending a rival's pace racing into the bend, emptied out nearing upper stretch. SURFIN WAVE, shuffled back out of tight quarters at the start, never gained contention. MARGO'S DELIGHT broke slowly, was caught in tight quarters just after the start and trailed throughout.
