SYD LICIOUS, urged to terms with several rivals on the pace three deep in the opening furlong, ceded the lead to a rival midway through the first turn to track that foe off the inside racing to the backstretch, continued with a steady bid to press the issue between foes racing into the far turn, gained a narrow advantage nearing upper stretch, moved well clear approaching the furlong marker and held sway to the end despite drifting out markedly under pressure in the final sixteenth. YUKAN DO IT TOO, reserved along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out four wide nearing the far turn while steadily moving to striking distance, shifted inwards under pressure racing through the stretch and couldn't match terms with the winner while proving best of the others. PLEASANTLYSURPRISE, prominent between foes in the opening stages, was eased off the pace nearing the backstretch to track those foes along the inside, came around a tiring foe racing into upper stretch to challenge inside the leaders but lacked the needed closing bid. DUNNOTARR, held up just off the first flight four deep racing to the backstretch, moved to challenge three deep between foes racing through the far turn but came up empty in the drive. POPLAR HOUSE was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained striking distance. NICKELACROSS, urged to the lead along the inside racing to the backstretch, emptied out racing through the far turn. JOHNS LION ducked out at the start, settled outside foes and soon trailed.
