TABLE GAMES raced unhurried tracking off the second flight while angling nearer to the inside in the opening stages, shifted out three wide on the second bend steadily gathering momentum, shifted out four deep nearing upper stretch while being roused to challenge, gained a clear advantage leaving midstretch and just held the challenge of GOLD FORMER to the end under steady handling. The latter, reserved just out of striking distance inside foes racing to the backstretch, shifted out splitting foes racing through the far turn while moving to contention, altered course five wide when lacking a path from which to challenge entering upper stretch and produced a solid late response to close the gap on the winner. SACRED GROUND was settled in last off the inside racing to the backstretch, came around foes on the far turn, angled six wide in upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the top pair but made an effort to edge a rival for a share. GO DOUG GO, bumped by KING ROOTIN TOOTIN while being held up just off the leaders racing to the first turn, switched outside foes racing to the backstretch racing just off the leaders, moved to challenge three deep entering the far turn, couldn't fend off the winner's bid and faded leaving the furlong marker. MCLARD, urged to the fore three deep racing into the first turn, angled to the inside on the backstretch, dueled for command along the rail into the second bend and gave way nearing midstretch. PRAIRIE BREEZE was settled off the leaders outside a rival from just out of striking distance in the opening half but offered no closing response. KING ROOTIN TOOTIN broke a step behind his rivals, was urged to gain a contending position three deep between foes while making some contact with GO DOUG GO racing into the first bend, continued tracking just off the leaders for a half, made a brief bid between foes racing through the far turn but quickly came up empty in upper stretch. BLUE LASER, prompted to secure a forward placing along the inside racing to the backstretch, steadily retreated after a half.
