### Footnotes

MILES AND MILES, was prompted to terms with a rival on the pace between foes racing into the first turn, was eased off the pace nearing the backstretch to track the leaders inside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn, continued to save ground to upper stretch while steadily drawing into striking distance, shifted outside the leader in late stages to challenge for command and narrowly prevailed under strong handling. HOOCHED EXPRESS, reserved out of striking distance along the along inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch while drawing into contention, continued to close the gap to late stages but was just outkicked by the winner. SON OF TIGER was urged to the lead while shifting to the inside racing into the backstretch, dictated the pace into the second bend, resisted the winner's challenge past midstretch but yielded to the top pair late. DON'T BLUFF came through close quarters to gain a forward placing along the inside while steadying slightly off the pacesetter racing through the first turn, shifted out tracking just off that foe racing to the second bend, was urged to challenge nearing upper stretch and steadily faded in late stages. DELAGO, caught four wide racing into the first turn, took up a position tracking off the second flight racing into the backstretch, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. SAAR, shuffled back out of tight quarters early, never gained contention. CODEWORD (IRE), caught three deep between foes in the opening stages, tracked the leaders in second flight outside a rival for six furlongs and steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
