TAR HEEL THRILL reserved early, entered the stretch three wide and rallied determinedly under a stiff drive. BLUE HEAT settled well, swung five wide into the stretch and finished well. SEEKING THE HONOR forced the pace, forged clear into the stretch and weakened late. KONA KID raced forwardly along the inside, lodged a bid on the turn and flattened out in the stretch. KING AJAX set a pressured pace, was headed leaving the turn and yielded. JOHNNIES BREEZE raced in striking position and faded. TWYLAS RED CAT was always outrun. ACTION ALL DAY chased along the inside and tired. GAGE PARK took no part.
