WILD EXPECTATIONS reserved early, swung five wide into the stretch and finished well. CARUSO settled well, entered the stretch three wide, established a clear lead but was caught. WILL'S HONEY passed tiring rivals. SOUTHERN VISION brushed early, was outpaced while five wide, moved out six wide into the stretch and had. no finishing punch. RED SKY DUBAI forced the pace, led on the turn and weakened in the stretch. A STEEL TRAP never menaced. FOXIE'S BOY gained the lead, was headed on the turn and gave way. WORTHTHEBOTHER stumbled at the start, leaned in early and tired. ALL TANKED UP raced forwardly while four wide, remained four wide into the stretch and faltered.
