WEGGIE was settled in hand along the rail in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch while making steady progress, came through when presented an opening approaching the sixteenth marker to challenge for command and narrowly prevailed under firm handling. TIMELESS FACTS angled to the inside tracking the leaders in second flight racing to the backstretch, made steady progress nearest the rail to challenge inside the pacesetter nearing the furlong marker, shifted out while gaining brief command between calls and just failed to contain the winner. THREE TICKETS was hustled to the lead outside a rival on the first turn, set the pace along the inside into the second bend, drifted out nearing the furlong marker and failed to sustain his momentum. CARTOUCHE tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch and continued evenly between foes in late stages. HOUSE OF USHER raced unhurried along the inside tracking off the second flight, shifted out entering the far turn commencing a steady advance to challenge four wide in upper stretch but flattened out late. SUMMER'S EMPIRE angled inwards in the opening stages to track between foes off the second flight, then continued evenly into the stretch. BISHOP CASEY, shuffled back out of tight quarters at the start, never gained contention. LEMON CUSTARD settled off the inside in the opening half and never seriously menaced. MONHOCRACY, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening quarter, chased the pacesetter into the far turn and emptied out. CARSON'S HAWK, forwardly placed three wide racing to the backstretch, retreated after a half.

MIGHTY FENIAN caught four wide racing to the backstretch, soon dropped out. AKA LILY'S LAD tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight, angled five wide after a half while lodging a brief bid but steadily faded racing through the far turn.
