SELZ hopped a bit at the start, but recovered quickly while being urged to the lead along the inside in the opening sixteenth, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn, extended the advantage racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end while drifting out in late stages under left handed encouragement. KEEP ON SHINING, momentarily loose in the post parade, ducked out at the start while throwing his head, was righted to track the leaders between foes in the second flight, shifted to the inside racing into the turn while being prompted to advance, gradually gained striking distance while shifting outside the winner leaving midstretch and continued to close the gap while being carried out a bit late. FLYBY DUBAI tracked the leader inside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, dropped off the pace racing into the turn, angled out five wide nearing midstretch and prevailed for a share while making no real impression. GERRY WITH A G broke sharply, prompted the pacesetter racing to the turn, drifted out nearing upper stretch and soon gave way. LAHSHAD tracked off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the turn and never gained striking distance. CAP TRICK was a brief factor racing four wide in the second flight to the turn but steadily retreated racing into upper stretch. MEDALQUEST broke slowly and trailed throughout. JUST FOR PAPA was scratched following the post parade and a consolation daily double was calculated as a result.
