KATHLEEN L gained the early lead, held well into the stretch, responded and fended off her rivals in the final furlong. SASSY BUCK reserved early, moved four wide into the stretch and finished well. TAHITIAN QUEEN settled well, moved five wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. SOUTH SIDE SALLY saved ground, angled out at the sixteenth marker and managed no late bid. EUROPA ROYALE chased the pace while four wide and had no rally. MARGRET S. outpaced while four wide, commenced a bid on the turn and flattened out in the stretch. LADY'S WORD passed tiring rivals. ILLINOIS BREEZE leaned out at the start, raced seven wide early and posed no threat. SOLA VINA stalked the pace and dropped back in the stretch. ECTON A FOOL showed little. PEPPERMINT FUDGE was forwardly placed and faded. KENDALOO faltered.
