Footnotes

BOBBY SANDS, on terms with the first flight three deep between foes racing into the first turn, was eased off the leaders entering the backstretch to track the pace between rivals under reserve in the second flight, steadily moved to striking distance while shifting out three deep between foes racing into upper stretch, angled out five wide nearing the furlong marker and produced a steady late response to wrest command in time under steady handling and some right handed encouragement. SLICK PARDONED ME settled just out of striking position racing off the inside to the backstretch, moved to challenge four wide racing through the far turn, gained a clear advantage near midstretch but couldn't contain the winner's bid. LITTLE FEAT joined the first flight four deep racing into the first turn attending the pace in hand, moved to force the issue three deep entering the second bend, continued between foes in that path to upper stretch but weakened leaving the furlong marker. GUADALCANAL joined the pace along the rail racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue inside foes racing into the far turn but weakened nearing midstretch. SEGURO was guided to the inside early to track just off the leaders as part of the second flight racing to the far turn but lacked the needed closing response. INSTILL was settled near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted four wide racing through the far turn, was fanned six wide entering upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. DOUG JUNIOR was urged between foes prompting the pace racing into the backstretch, continued under pressure between foes on the second bend and gave way entering upper stretch.
