PART'N PARCEL broke readily to secure a forward placing along the inside racing into the first turn, switched outside the pacesetter entering the backstretch while moving to terms with that foe, pressed the issue on the far turn to gain a narrow advantage racing into upper stretch, drifted out markedly in the last furlong despite brisk right handed pressure but just edged LOST FORTY in time. The latter came through close quarters at the break, was urged to secure the lead along the rail racing into the first turn, dueled for command inside a rival into upper stretch, moved to strike the front between calls leaving the furlong marker but couldn't quite contain the winner's final bid. LEMON CUSTARD, reserved outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, was urged to advance while angling nearer to the inside racing through the far turn, split foes just off the inside entering upper stretch and continued willingly inside the top pair to the end to close the gap while earning a share. SICOMORO, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages, tracked the leaders inside a rival in second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out a bit entering upper stretch but had no closing bid. BISHOP CASEY was settled between foes in the last flight in the opening half, shifted out entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve position four deep between rivals while

making no real impression. SHIP'S CABIN, reserved off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, came under pressure to advance on the far turn but offered no closing bid. NO SONG N DANCE, urged to secure a contending position four deep racing to the backstretch, continued outside foes tracking off the second flight racing to the second bend but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. AWESOME RULES was settled in the last flight saving ground to the backstretch but never gained contention. I. M. BOOMER, in close quarters at the start, was urged to contend three deep between foes racing into the first turn, continued outside a rival in the second flight on the backstretch and steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
