SANDIA CREST angled nearer to the inside early while taking up a position inside foes in the second flight, continued near the inside into the second bend under patient handling, was urged to advance inside foes when presented an opening leaving the quarter mile marker to challenge for command, then wrested a narrow advantage in late stages to prevail under firm handling. MAD GENIUS, forwardly placed stalking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, was urged to challenge the leader angling out three wide racing into upper stretch, shifted inwards under pressure disputing the issue outside the eventual winner past midstretch but couldn't quite match that foe in the final sixteenth. REAL POWER was settled off the second flight near the inside racing to the backstretch, gradually drew into striking distance leaving the far turn while shifting out three wide and continued to make mild progress to the end while narrowly prevailing for a share. NO APOLOGIZES broke a bit awkwardly, settled in last racing to the far turn, gathered momentum racing into upper stretch while shifting out four wide and made some belated progress while missing for third. STRIKING HIGHT tracked just off the first flight three wide between foes racing to the backstretch, continued in that path into the second bend and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. PRICELESS SHORE was urged to the lead racing into the first turn, dictated the pace along the inside to the far turn, shifted out racing into upper stretch but quickly gave way once headed by the top pair. LETHAL, caught four wide racing to the backstretch while under some prompting to contend, steadily retreated racing into the far turn.
