Footnotes

MAGIC BULLET was urged to the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on his own courage maintaining a narrow advantage racing to the far turn, was headed nearing upper stretch but continued resolutely under pressure to turn back rivals while drifting out late under firm left handed encouragement. GOLD LEGION, reserved off the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out before a half commencing an early advance, moved to challenge three deep racing into the far turn, continued to force the issue in that path to upper stretch but couldn't match the winner late while prevailing for place honors. HE'S BONAFIDE, forwardly placed attending a rival's pace racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue between foes entering the far turn to upper stretch but weakened leaving the furlong marker. ULTIMATE X. took up a position just off the first flight tracking the leaders in the opening stages, continued between foes through the backstretch, couldn't gain terms with the first flight but continued evenly along the inside through the lane. ALL IN SLEW gained a position outside a rival in the second flight racing into the first turn, continued three deep on the backstretch, shifted out four wide racing through the stretch while being urged to advance but had no rally. PEYTONVILLE was guided to the inside early to take up a position just off the second flight, made some brief progress inside foes to gain some position after a half but quickly flattened out racing through the far turn. MY SONNY BOY settled into stride along the inside early and never gained contention. HAPMAN was never a factor.
