STATIC KILL was urged to gain a forward placing along the inside racing just off the pacesetter into the bend, shifted out three deep in upper stretch while being urged to challenge, took over leaving the furlong marker and drew away under firm encouragement. CATFEINATED tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, angled inside nearing upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to prevail for place honors. GO GETEM broke slowly, saved ground to upper stretch, then shifted out splitting foes four deep in the closing stages to improve his position. PIRATES VOW was hustled to the lead, set the pace on a clear margin to upper stretch but gave out leaving the furlong marker. ROARIN MISSILE broke readily to track just off the pacesetter outside the eventual winner racing into the turn and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. BUG JUICE tracked the leaders four deep in the second flight racing into the turn and steadily faded in that path entering upper stretch. OUTLAW ZEN, caught wide throughout, proved no factor. KELLY LEAK tracked off the second flight between foes, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch and never proved a serious threat. MR. FLEXIBLE, caught five deep racing to the turn while behind the second flight, never seriously menaced. COOL BULLET showed little.
