Footnotes

THERE'S NO TELLING, urged to join the pace four deep between foes in the opening furlong, gained the advantage after the opening quarter while shifting nearer to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin through the bend remaining a bit off the rail and held sway to the end under brisk handling. GIMME A DOUBLE, forwardly placed five deep tracking just off the leaders in the opening stages, shifted in nearing the turn to track just off the pacesetter racing three deep between foes, continued in that path to upper stretch and proved best of the others while failing to gain even terms with the winner. GRASS BLADE, in touch with the leaders between foes in the opening furlong, tracked the pacesetter along the rail racing into the turn and weakened in

that path in late stages. STEEL HAMMER, pinched back at the start, settled into stride, was urged to advance while shifting outside foes racing into the turn, continued with a steady six wide run into upper stretch and gained position to the end. SERRATED EDGE angled inwards in the opening stages to track just off the leaders between foes racing into the turn, then split foes three wide racing into upper stretch to gain some position while continuing evenly. PROUD JACKSON tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight early, raced four wide between foes on the turn to upper stretch and steadily faded in late stages. ON THE RUN hopped at the start, settled in last racing well off the inside and never gained contention. FEAR NOR FAVOR, urged along racing five wide into the turn, retreated from contention early. PETER LOUIS flashed brief pace three deep between foes in the opening quarter but steadily faded racing through the turn. HIGH'R VOLTAGE was urged to contend along the rail in the opening stages, continued to track off the second flight saving ground on the bend but steadily faded racing into the stretch. ANTHONY'S PRAYER, urged to contend four deep between foes in the opening furlong, dropped out of contention early.
