Footnotes

FORGIVE YOUR SINS, unhurried along the inside tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance, made a steady advance along the rail entering the bend, shifted out midstretch to challenge LA VENGANSA and edged that rival approaching the wire under firm encouragement. The latter was urged to dispute the pace from the break while angling to the rail, edged forward to a clear advantage in upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner. KNOWWHATIMEAN bobbed at the break, was reserved in hand between foes early, angled in to the rail entering the turn and made some belated progress inside foes to gain a share. PUBLISH, unhurried seven wide in the opening stages racing just off the first flight, made steady progress four and five deep racing into upper stretch but had no final bid. PROUD MCKEE, shuffled back out of close quarters in the opening furlong, swung out five wide entering upper stretch and made some belated progress. BOSCO RULES settled in hand outside foes racing to the bend, continued five deep into upper stretch, then angled inside racing through the stretch while improving his position to the end. AWESOME RULES tracked off the second flight along the inside racing into the turn but lacked the needed closing response. ICANDAZZLE prompted the pace outside a rival from the break, deued for command into the bend and gave way near midstretch. NAFIR'S LAD was urged to contend four deep between foes racing into the turn and retreated in upper stretch. MASTER COMMANDER never seriously menaced. A ROGUE SNUCK IN flashed brief pace between foes but was through after a half. ONLINE CODE was urged to contend six deep between foes but was spent after three furlongs.
