**Footnotes**

GOOD CHEMISTRY, caught four wide between foes taking up a position in the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued outside foes in that position to the second bend, commenced a steady, four wide bid racing through the far turn to upper stretch and continued under firm handling in a prolonged drive to gain a narrow advantage nearing the wire. DAD ARE WE HERE, caught five wide racing into the first turn while prompted to gain a contending position, continued outside foes tracking just off the second flight racing into the far turn, was urged to advance while being fanned six wide racing through upper stretch and found his best stride late to close the gap while prevailing for place honors. CALMER THAN YOU joined the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, shifted out disputing the issue three deep between foes racing into the second bend, continued in an extended skirmish for command past midstretch but was just outfinished in the final stages. YANKEE DEALER settled off the second flight between foes racing to the backstretch, split foes three deep midway through the far turn while moving to striking distance, shifted out five wide nearing midstretch while being urged to challenge but was outkicked. PLEASANT CLOSING, urged to secure the lead along the rail racing into the first turn, dueled inside foes for command racing through

the far turn to upper stretch and gave way in the final strides. FUN ON THE BAYOU, reserved in last in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn, angled seven wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress. MCLARD angled inwards in the opening stages to track just off the first flight, was urged to split foes challenging for command racing into the far turn, dueled between foes to upper stretch but came up empty in the drive. HATTAASH stumbled at the start, was collected to track off the second flight between foes racing to the far turn, angled inside racing into the stretch but had no rally. STAR OF PARADISE, pulling a bit along the inside while gaining a position in the second flight after a half, steadily retreated racing into the far turn. SWITCHING TO GLIDE, held up three deep between foes in the second flight, continued under reserve through the backstretch, was urged to advance four wide into the second bend but quickly emptied out. CONTROL TOWER angled inwards in the opening stages while climbing a bit racing into the first turn and never gained contention.
