Footnotes

ACE RICH, came through close quarters in the opening stages to gain a contending position just off the leaders racing to the bend, continued with a steady three wide advance on the turn to challenge for command in upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and just held the challenge of TWYLAS RED CAT under pressure. The latter threw his head at the start, was settled into stride while shifting nearer to the inside racing into the turn, split foes three wide racing through the stretch and was making steady progress to challenge just inside the winner approaching the wire. DOONEY ROCK, shuffled back at the back start, tracked off the second flight racing into the turn while briefly awaiting an opening, shifted out to split foes four wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly between foes to prevail for a share. CRYPTO GULCH, forced in at the start, settled in last racing to the turn, swung out seven wide racing through the stretch and made some belated progress. ALABAMA CLAY sprinted to the lead along the rail in the opening stages, set the pace into upper stretch and gave out once headed by the winner. HEY RED broke inwards, raced in tight quarters between foes as part of the second flight

in the opening stages, shifted out five wide racing through the turn and offered no rally. BIGSURPRISEMISTER, urged to position three deep between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, couldn't produce the needed late response. FOREST RUN, urged to contend four wide early, shifted in to prompted the pacesetter between foes racing through the turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. JOHNS LION, caught five wide in the opening stages, tracked the leaders outside foes racing as part of the second flight into the turn and steadily faded entering upper stretch. IZZY GOLDEN broke inwards bumping BIGTIME MAC, was urged to gain a position along the inside in the second flight racing through the backstretch but retreated from contention early. CAUSE CAUSE CAUSE, caught four wide between foes in the second flight in the opening stages, retreated early. BIGTIME MAC, bumped, then forced into CRYPTO GULCH at the start, continued erratically between foes while being prompted to gain some position racing into the turn but emptied out abruptly in upper stretch.
