Footnotes

SPECIAL ED M D joined the pace outside a rival soon after the break, made a steady effort racing into the turn to assume command on his own courage,

then steadily extended his advantage through the stretch under firm handling. TIP OF THE LAKE tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the bend, angled to the inside on the turn, couldn't gain terms with the leader but proved best of the others. ANGEL FIRST CLASS broke inwards bumping IN ALL DIRECTIONS, was righted to gain a position three deep racing in the second flight racing to the turn, moved to challenge in that path after a half but flattened out in the drive. CHAMBER OF BULLETS, reserved outside a rival in the last flight early, shifted out five wide on the turn making steady progress and continued to improve position outside foes to late stages. AMRAM, held up off the second flight three deep between foes racing to the turn, continued evenly in that position racing into the stretch. DEPUTY HAWK, held up off the second flight between foes racing into the turn, couldn't produce the needed late response. FEAR NOR FAVOR, reserved off the inside in the last flight racing to the bend, never gained contention. SPECTACULAR DEMI was a brief factor inside foes in the second flight but retreated from contention early. IN ALL DIRECTIONS, bumped at the start, was urged to contention racing four wide into the turn but flattened out in upper stretch. RUSTY'S RED BOY bobbed at the start, tracked off the second flight along the inside racing to the bend and never gained contention. LET ME DOWN EASY briefly disputed the pace along the inside and steadily retreated on the turn.
