KIND REGARDS broke readily to gain a narrow advantage from between foes in the opening stages, disputed the pace outside a rival racing into the bend, continued in an extended skirmish past midstretch and edged forward in late stages under firm encouragement. ALL TANKED UP was urged to terms inside the pacesetter racing through the backstretch, pressed the issue along the rail past the furlong marker but was narrowly outfinished. SIGNSEALNDELIVER, reserved off the second flight while angling to the inside, saved ground to upper stretch, advanced inside foes to striking position in upper stretch, then shifted out three wide in late stages while continuing willingly to close the gap. BID'S REWARD, urged to position inside foes in the second flight in the opening quarter, tracked the leaders along the rail on the bend, shifted out nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. J. PA, within striking distance three deep in the opening stages, was eased off the leaders to track the pace outside foes in the second flight racing into the turn but offered no closing bid. HAPMAN, lightly rated between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, steadily faded entering upper stretch. ROARIN MISSILE was settled off the second flight early and never gained contention.
